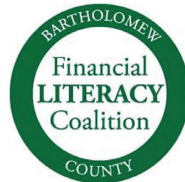

Personal Loan Service

United Way has partnered with Centra Credit Union to provide partnered loans of up to \$1,000 for employees in need.

- 12 month loan provided by Centra Credit Union
- 4% Interest Rate
- Applicant will open a Centra savings account (\$5 minimum deposit upon opening)
- United Way will pre-screen applicant to determine eligibility
- Loan will be defaulted after 60 days. Balance will be paid from the UW/Centra capitalization
